

## **NEW RECYCLING SERVICES CONTRACT INFORMATION**

The Village of Glencoe's new 5-year recycling services agreement with Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) of Morton Grove, is scheduled to begin on Monday, February 29. The Village has begun a multi-stage informational campaign to fully inform residents about the transition plan. On Friday, January 15, an initial notification letter was sent to all households within the Village of Glencoe informing residents about the new recycling service provider, and providing contact information for resident questions. A new recycling webpage will be available for residents as a resource to stay current on any new information regarding the cart roll-out, or as a reference guide for what can be placed within recycling containers. A second informational mailing is expected to go out in early February.



Residents will be issued a new 95-gallon cart (pictured here) as a part of the new agreement with LRS. These new carts will be distributed the week of February 22. During that week, residents should place their Groot container at the curb on their regular collection day for collection, but should **not** bring the emptied cart back to their residence. The emptied recycling cart will be collected by Groot, and a new 95-gallon Village recycling cart will be delivered to each residence the same day. More information on this process will be provided in advance of February 22.
