



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING SERVICE TRANSITION

- Beginning the week of February 22, residents should place their Groot recycling cart(s) at the curb on their regular collection day.
- The Groot cart will be emptied and removed; a new Village recycling cart (grey with blue lid) will be dropped off. *IMPORTANT: Leave the empty Groot cart at the curb for Groot to retrieve.*
- All residential single-family and multi-family customers will receive a new 95-gallon recycling cart as the standard service.
- Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) will start collecting recycling, on your regular collection day, beginning Monday, February 29.
- Residents who expect to be out of town during the week of February 22 should place their Groot recycling cart out at the curb on their first regular collection day upon their return, and not pull it back in.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING GUIDELINES



PAPER

Newspapers/ Magazines
 Catalogs/ Telephone Books
 Kraft Brown Paper Bags
 Corrugated Cardboard (*flattened*)
 Cereal Boxes (*food boxes in general*)
 Junk Mail
 Window Envelopes
 Mixed Paper



METAL

Aluminum Cans
 Aluminum Foil
 Steel or Tin Cans
 (*labels may remain on cans*)
 Empty Aerosol Cans
 Aluminum Baking Trays
 Pie Tins



GLASS

Glass Bottles
 (*clear, brown, green or blue*)
 Glass Jars
 (*clear, brown, green or blue*)



MILK CARTON/ DRINK BOXES

Gable Top Milk Cartons
 Juice Cartons (*rinsed and dry*)
 Juice Boxes (*rinsed and dry*)



PLASTIC

Pop Bottles
 Milk Containers (*rinsed and dry*)
 Water Bottles (*with caps*)
 Margarine/ Butter Tubs
 (*no food residue*)
 Toiletry/ Beauty-Aid Bottles
 Laundry Detergent Bottles

Please recycle plastics #1-#5 and #7 (no #6)

Recycling collection is once per week on your regular garbage collection day. Recycling is picked up at the curb in 95-gallon recycling carts provided by the Village.

Carts must be placed close to the street with the handle facing your house. All recycling must be ready for collection no later than 7:00 am the day of collection.

All recyclables can be placed together in the cart; no separation is required. Do not place your recyclables in plastic bags in your cart. Plastic grocery bags can be recycled at your local grocery store.

Although not part of the single-stream recycling program, household batteries, fluorescent light bulbs and holiday lights can be dropped off, for recycling and proper disposal, in the vestibule at the Public Works Service Building (320 Hazel Ave) Monday thru Friday, 8:00 am to 3:30 pm.

Call the Village at 847.835.4134 to schedule an appointment to drop off any electronic waste, which may not be disposed with your garbage. This free service is by appointment only.

- Glass (*non bottle or jar*)
- Glass (*windows*)
- Food
- Liquids
- Plastic (*saran wrap*)
- Plates or dishes
- Polystyrene
- Waxed cardboard
- Waxed paper
