## EMPLOYEE PARKING IN GLENCOE

All current employee B, H, and D-Permits will be reissued on March 01, 2008. New employee free parking permits will be issued to applicant business owners or managers to be issued to authorized employees. If you choose not to comply with conditions requiring your employees to park in free designated long term parking spaces, fee parking is available in the several commuter lots adjacent to the train tracks. Effective with this new issuance of parking permits, the Department of Public Safety will be reviewing outstanding violations of employee parking in the business district on a quarterly basis. The business owners' Village Business license status will be considered for any unpaid outstanding employee tickets.

### **Employee Parking:**

Employees of the various businesses located in the Village can obtain free permit parking passes issued by the Department of Public Safety allowing them to park for free (as spaces are available) in one of several permit zones. There are multiple permits for parking in the business district. Your permit assignment will designate what parking area you will be required to use. Any employee is eligible for a free parking permit providing they have no outstanding parking tickets in Glencoe and receive authorization from their owner / manager.

### **B-Permit**

The B-Permit allows the holder to park in the Temple Court lot, at designated spaces on Park Avenue between Grove and Greenwood, and on Grove just south of Park Avenue.

### **H-Permit**

The H-Permit allows the holder to park on Old Greenbay Road (east of the train tracks) north of Dennis Lane, and on Glencoe Drive. The parking spaces are appropriately signed for permit parking.

### **D-Permit**

D-Permits allow the holder to park in the southeast (east of the train tracks, south of Park Avenue) commuter parking lot.

Unless otherwise specified, all permit zones are enforced between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Employees wishing to obtain a permit must apply with the Public Safety Department, complete the application signed by the owner / manager to verify employment within the business district and have no outstanding parking tickets. A business with an employee who has accumulated unpaid parking tickets will be notified on a quarterly basis. All outstanding employee parking tickets must be resolved or your Village of Glencoe business license could be suspended until resolution is met.

# **\*\*Parking fines increase beginning**

## **March 01, 2008\*\***

### **Parking Fine Fee Schedule:**

Graduated fines for vehicle parked in excess of the two-hour time limit will be applied with fines up to \$150.00 per ticket for repeat offenders.

6	\$50.00
7	\$75.00
8	\$100.00
9	\$125.00
10 and above	\$150.00

**Handicap Parking Violation**

**\$250.00**

**All other parking violations**

**\$25.00 – 20 day late fee: \$50.00**

**Vehicles may be immobilized (booted) for five (5) unpaid parking tickets. Boot removal requires payment of all outstanding parking tickets and a removal fee of and additional \$100.00.**

**The driver's license of a vehicle owner with ten (10) unpaid tickets may be suspended in the State of Illinois.**
