# WEEKLY NEWS BRIEFING

### GLENCOE DRIVE WATER MAIN

Work has commenced on the north end of the project near Green Bay Road and the mainline installation will be completed sometime this week. The new water main will be pressure tested and chlorinated and then put into service. The project is expected to be completed the week of October 19. Restoration of the work area will occur after the transition of services to the new main.

As a component of this project, the intersection of Glencoe Drive and Tudor Court (just west of Green Bay Road in the Business District) **will be closed Saturday, October 10 from 7am to 3:30pm**. Tudor Court will be closed to thru traffic traveling to Green Bay Road but Parking on Tudor Court will remain open. During the closure hours, Tudor Court will be modified from one-way traffic to two-way with assistance from Public Works Staff. Please use caution when traveling on Tudor Court during this traffic pattern modification and allow Public Works Staff to assist you in entering and leaving this area.

## **SHERIDAN ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT**

IDOT's maintenance resurfacing improvement on Sheridan Road from Lake Cook Road to Winnetka Avenue in the Villages of Glencoe and Winnetka is currently underway. Curb replacement is near completion within the Glencoe portion of this project. Grinding of the asphalt pavement surface will begin the week of October 12. This is a moving operation and will be completed under daytime lane closures around the work zone. Bituminous transition joints will be placed at cross-streets and at the north and south ends of the project. Gas main installation within the ravine is nearly completed, and should alleviate some traffic backups. ## **PARKWAY LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK**

The Village's annual Curbside Leaf Collection Program will be offered for seven weeks beginning Monday, October 13. Leaves will be collected from the parkway area in all residential neighborhoods.

Residents participating in the Leaf Collection Program are asked to note the following:

- Leaves should be piled in a row along the parkway in front of your property and should not be placed in the street under any circumstance. Leaf piles in the street are a traffic hazard and can clog the storm sewer basins, resulting in street flooding. A long, low row is better than a single large pile and limits the blowing of leaves into the street or back onto the yard.
- The Village will be operating multiple parkway leaf collection crews continually during the program and anticipates passing through every neighborhood 4-5 times before the end of November. Residents are encouraged to check the Village website for an area-by-area map and estimated progress schedule. The final pass will be made the last week of November and the last day of collection will occur on November 27.
- Residents who use a landscape contractor to maintain their yard are urged to have the contractor remove leaves at the time their yard is serviced. Most residents who use landscape contractors are paying for disposal of leaves as part of their service.

Remember, use of gasoline powered leaf blowers is permitted beginning September 15 through December 15. Commercial landscape maintenance contractors may operate Monday - Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00p.m. Commercial landscape maintenance contractors are prohibited from working on Sundays and holidays.

## HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS FROM GLENCOE PUBLIC SAFETY

To make sure even the scariest costumes are safe, keep the following in mind;

- Try makeup instead of masks; it's more comfortable and doesn't obstruct the vision the masks can.
- Check to ensure that costumes are flame-retardant.
- Wear well-fitting shoes to avoid trips and falls.
- Avoid costumes that drag on the ground.
- Have each child carry or wear something lit, such as a flashlight, glow bracelet or necklace or flashing attire for visibility. At least one person in each group should carry a flashlight.
- Think "practical" over "cute" when picking a trick or treat goody bag or container.
- Review the route for Trick-or-Treating beforehand and set a time when kids should be home. Also, have a plan if your child gets separated from the group. A responsible adult or older teen should accompany each group.
- Only trick or treat at houses that are lit.
- Watch for traffic, obey all traffic signs, look before crossing the street, and never cross between parked cars or in the middle of the block.



### Fire Safety;

- Avoid using Halloween decorations with real flames.
- Use battery operated lights to illuminate your pumpkins.
- If you must use real candles, never leave them unattended and keep away from curtains
