PARKWAY LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

The Village's annual parkway leaf collection program is drawing to a close. This year the last day for residents to put loose leaves on the parkway will be Monday, November 23. However, the Village will continue to pick up bagged

yard waste each Wednesday until December 9. For Wednesday yard waste pick up, each bag, container, or bundle must display a current Village Yard Waste Collection sticker (unless the Yard Waste Collection Service Subscription was purchased for the season), or items will not be collected.

PLAN COMMISSION – NOVEMBER 18

The November 18 Plan Commission meeting was held at the Glencoe Historical Society Museum at 375 Park Avenue, and included a special presentation on the current exhibit and recent findings indicating that Frank Lloyd Wright and Jens Jensen collaborated on a design for Glencoe's downtown in 1912. The presentation included additional information that is not currently exhibited, including early influences on Glencoe's street layout design dating back to the 1870s, George Maher's designs for downtown Glencoe from 1919, and Maher's 1924 plans and design for the Woman's Library Club that included a large theatre space never fully realized due to the construction of Misner Auditorium at Central School. The history of the formation of the Plan Commission, including its scope of work and membership, was also presented. The next Plan Commission meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 18 at 7:30 p.m. at Village Hall. Stay tuned to the project website, <http://glencoetuneup.com>, for further information. The Historical Society's Wright in Glencoe exhibit is open to the public Wednesdays (10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.) and Sundays (1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.).

FINANCE COMMITTEE – NOVEMBER 17

The Finance Committee met on November 17 and reviewed the monthly treasurer's report, which noted that the Village's general fund and other major funds are on target with the FY 2016 budget, and completed a preliminary review of the FY 2017 property tax levy. The Committee discussed State of Illinois revenues (collected by the State on behalf of the Village and remitted to the Village), which are currently being withheld by the State. The Committee discussed the Village's current financial policies, which guide the Village's annual budget development, and will continue discussing the Village's financial policies and draft FY 2017 budget over the next several meetings.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – NOVEMBER 19

The Committee of the Whole met on November 17 prior and began an initial discussion regarding Village services (including an initial discussion regarding

core services and enhanced services), as part of the Village Board's and staff's ongoing review of services, which will continue over the next several months.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETING – NOVEMBER 19

At the November 19 Village Board Meeting, the Board adopted a resolution honoring former Village President Roland Calhoun for his upcoming 90th birthday. The resolution commemorated his lifelong contributions to the Village of Glencoe, which have enhanced the Village through his passion, enthusiasm, and enduring volunteerism.

The Board also adopted an ordinance amending the building permit extension policy to allow homeowners facing challenges due to special scenarios, such as contractor default, severe weather, and other causes of work stoppage beyond their control to request a building permit extension. The Board also adopted a resolution authorizing purchase of a new sprinkler control system for the Glencoe Golf Club. The new system will have improved functionality and allow for remote access to sprinkler controls leading to improved efficiency.

Lastly, the Board received a preliminary presentation on the 2015 Tax Levy Ordinance which will be considered at the December Village Board Meeting. The 2015 Tax Levy Ordinance includes a .86% increase over the extended taxes from the previous year, which equals \$113,639.




