





Watts Ice Center Opening Delayed *Mechanical Failure Delays Outdoor Rink Opening*

Glencoe Park District announced today that Watts Ice Center will not open on Friday, November 27 as planned. The delay is attributed to a mechanical failure on the main rink cooling floor, which developed when the system was turned on for the season.

“Unfortunately, the mechanical failure is not something we can plan for. It’s impossible to identify this kind of problem until the unit is in operation,” said Director of Parks Chris Leiner. To fix the problem, Associated Technical Services has been contracted to provide an ultrasonic leak detection test, similar to the technology used to determine water main breaks without cutting concrete. If Associated Technical Services can determine the leak location, the next step is to excavate the concrete surface, repair the poly tubing, pour new concrete, and move forward with rink prep.

“We will have more information on opening both rinks once Associated Technical Services evaluates the system on Friday,” said Watts Ice Center Facility Manager David Johnson.

All programs scheduled for Friday, November 27 (including Skate-A-Thon) and Saturday, November 28 are cancelled at this time. Class participants and rink renters will be notified by phone 24-hours in advance of rink closures. “If you do not hear from us, class is on as scheduled,” said Johnson.

Glencoe Park District staff will be working throughout the holiday weekend to ensure the rink is ready to open as soon as possible. “Skating Thanksgiving weekend at Watts has been a long-standing Glencoe tradition,” said Lisa Sheppard, Executive Director. “We are disappointed to delay opening weekend, but we are committed to opening Watts Ice Center as soon as possible.”

About Watts Ice Center

Glencoe Park District’s outdoor refrigerated skating facility, operates (weather permitting) the day after Thanksgiving through the first Sunday in March. This unique facility features two outdoor artificial ice rinks, which opened in 1972. The facility was updated in 2001 and is today the home of figure skating lessons, ice hockey, and recreational skating. Amenities include a regulation hockey rink, a studio rink, a mini-pro shop, a concession stand, a recreation room and a program room. The recreation room is available year round for private party rentals and Park District programs.
