CHASE BANK BUILDING CONSTRUCTION PROCEEDING

This winter has been exceptionally difficult for the Chicago-area construction industry and the Chase Bank project at 332 Park Avenue in downtown Glencoe is no exception. Numerous working days were lost due to the record cold and near continuous snow events. Adding to that, the logistics of working on a tight jobsite in the middle of an active downtown business district have made the construction process very challenging. Despite these difficulties, the project has continued construction throughout most of the winter.

As a result, the building shell is nearly completed and the interior build is well underway. This week, a substantial quantity of the building's masonry work was completed, and tarps that had been providing weather protection

were removed highlighting the attractive brick and limestone façade (see photo below). Now that weather is improving the primary focus will be completion of the exterior work including window installation, remaining underground utility work and restoration of the sidewalk and public right-of-way area. Work will continue concurrently on the interior over the next two months.

The project is on track to be completed in late May.
