NEW TRIER TOWNSHIP ANNUAL TOWN HALL MEETING

The 165th Annual New Trier Township Town Meeting will be Tuesday, April 8 at the Winnetka Community House at 620 Lincoln Avenue. The reception will begin at 6:30 p.m. with the program starting at 7:30 p.m. The Annual Town Meeting is one of the oldest traditions of Township government in which all Illinois Townships meet on the same day in April to review the official business of Township government.



Dr. James J. Phillips, a township resident and Vice President for Athletics and Recreation of Northwestern University, will deliver the keynote address. Dr. Phillips will speak on the subject of the responsibility of individuals and organizations to contribute to the community. Dr. Phillips will share his insights on the value of a mutually beneficial relationship between the University and its surrounding community. Dr. Phillips is an ardent believer that all residents have a role to play in perpetuating the success of Township programs in support of our neighbors.

The meeting will also include presentations of Township accomplishments and awards including the annual Friend of the Township Award which will be bestowed upon The Grand Food Center in recognition of their long-term commitment to the New Trier Township Food Pantry.
