





FIRE AT WRITERS THEATRE

At approximately 3:15 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2015, the Glencoe Department of Public Safety and several neighboring fire departments responded to a fire at the Writers Theatre construction site, located at 325 Tudor Court. The fire was contained to building materials stored on the roof, which resulted in an undetermined amount of damage to those materials. At this time, the structure does not appear to have been damaged by the fire. The fire was extinguished by 5:20 p.m. Local street closures were required during firefighting activities and were re-opened by early evening, Metra service was not interrupted, and an adjacent park was closed overnight for site security reasons. One construction site worker was transported to Highland Park Hospital for smoke inhalation, he was treated and released. The cause and origin of the fire is currently under investigation. Additional information will be provided following the conclusion of the investigation.



PLAN COMMISSION MEETING – APRIL 29

At the April 29th meeting, members of the Plan Commission continued discussion on the Downtown TuneUp planning process. Two draft reports prepared by staff were reviewed. The first report provided a summary of the Listening & Learning Phase of the process that included a variety of public engagement opportunities through the Candy Chang ideas chalkboards, quick poll questions and 'share an idea' features on the TuneUp website, and the seven topical panel discussions hosted by the Plan Commission. Together, these opportunities provided insight from residents, Village officials, representatives of the business community, and others regarding needs, trends, desires, and what needs changing relative to downtown. The second report included draft policies for the Plan Commission to consider for the public spaces, private property, and publically owned property downtown. The foundation for this report was provided by the findings from the past 10+ months, including those themes that emerged from the Listening & Learning Phase, discussion during Plan Commission meetings, and reports from staff

experts relative to economic sustainability and parking. Discussion during the meeting further refined the policies and an updated draft will be reviewed at the next Plan Commission meeting on May 13th.
