



GLENCOE GRAND PRIX

GREEN BAY ROAD MAINTENANCE RESURFACING PROJECT

A contract for the maintenance resurfacing improvement on Green Bay Road in the Village of Glencoe has been awarded to Peter Baker & Sons of Lake Bluff. This \$1.14 million improvement project includes the milling and resurfacing of 1.6 miles of Green Bay Road from Park Avenue to Lake Cook Road. The scope of work for this improvement will also include base patching, some spot curb replacement and the construction of a new landscaped median just north of Park Avenue. Peter Baker will mobilize to begin work on June 1 and all work is expected to be completed by July 31, weather permitting. Green Bay Road will remain open to traffic during construction; however, bicyclists are encouraged to monitor conditions and utilize alternate route as posted. VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM PLANNING REPORT PUBLIC MEETINGS

The Village hosted a community open house to discuss the water supply planning report on May 28, which included a presentation by Village staff and a representative from Strand Associates that summarized information presented to the Village Board at its March 19, 2015 meeting. After the presentation, residents and Village staff participated in a question-and-answer session regarding the water supply planning report. The Glencoe Community Relations Forum will host Community Forums about the water supply planning report on June 8 (held at the Glencoe Union Church at 7 p.m.) and June 27 (held at the Glencoe Public Library at 10 a.m.). The Community Forums will feature an abbreviated version of the presentation made at the open house, as well as question-and-answer sessions. These meetings are intended as informational sessions in which Village staff and residents can share information, comments, and questions about the Village's water supply plan, and no decisions will be made at these meetings.
