NEWS FROM THE GLENCOE GOLF CLUB

The Glencoe Golf Club hosted an Illinois Open Qualifier on June 8. This was the second of seven qualifying events for the 66th Open Championship. Over 100 top professionals and amateurs in the state competed for 52 available spots, the largest qualifying field for the Championship. The tournament ended in a playoff among 13 players tied at 78 for the last 11 qualifying spots. The low score of the event was a 69, shot by Patrick Flavin of Highwood. the Glencoe Golf Club both made the cut and will be moving on to the Illinois Open Championship.

Beginning Thursday, June 18, 2015, the Village will hold Committee of the Whole public meetings at 5:30 p.m. on the third Thursday of the month, preceding the regular Village Board of Trustees meeting. The Village's Finance Committee will move its regular meetings to the third Tuesday of the month at 7:30 a.m. Committee of the Whole and Finance Committee meetings are public meetings open to members of the public and members of the press, and will be held at Village Hall.

The Village President will preside over the Committee of the Whole, which is comprised of the Board of Trustees. The Committee of the Whole meeting is intended for discussion, and no formal Board action will be taken at Committee of the Whole meetings, as action can only be taken at a regular Village Board meeting. The Committee of the Whole meeting is an opportunity for the Village Board to engage in dialogue on items brought forth by staff that require dialogue and review of policy before such items are placed on a regular Village Board meeting agenda for formal consideration. Generally, the Committee of the Whole will discuss items at least one month prior to such items being placed on the regular Village Board meeting agenda for formal consideration and approval.
