DUNDEE ROAD DETOUR TO CONTINUE THROUGH JUNE 27

While originally expected to be open to traffic on June 20, Dundee Road will remain closed to all through traffic from Forestway Drive to Bluff Road for the installation of a new storm sewer. Please follow the posted detour route if travel takes you east- or west-bound on Dundee Road. It is anticipated that this portion of Dundee road will re-open to traffic by Monday, June 27.

East-bound traffic is detoured from Hohlfelder Road to Westley Road and then to Green Bay Road; west-bound traffic is detoured from Green Bay Road to Westley Road and then to Hohlfelder Road. Please remember to follow the posted speed limits and watch for construction workers when traveling by the construction area. FINANCE COMMITTEE - JUNE 16

The Finance Committee met on June 16 and discussed the Village's monthly financial reports. One quarter of the year into Fiscal Year 2017, Village finances remain on track with expectations. The Committee discussed the ongoing budget stalemate in Springfield that again threatens to place pressure on the Village's finances if local revenues are not distributed by the State. The Committee also discussed the timeline for the upcoming \$5 million dollar bond sale issuance, the remainder of the 2015 referendum voter-approved bond funds for stormwater improvements and other capital projects. It is expected that a Parameters Ordinance for the bond sale will be considered at the July 21 Village Board meeting, with the bond sale taking place in August.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETING - JUNE 16

At the June 16 Village Board Meeting, the Board approved a contract with Revize Software Systems for Village Website Redesign Services as well as an additional Class B-2 Liquor License for the new Glencoe Wine Bar that will be located at 338 Tudor Court. The Village Board also received a presentation and participated in an exercise lead by Plan Commission Chair Caren Thomas. Ms. Thomas shared an update on the Plan Commission's draft downtown plan as well as several interactive exhibits that were used to solicit community feedback at recent Plan Commission open houses.

Skokie Ridge Storm Basin Improvements

The final segment of storm sewer work is underway on Dundee Road between Forest Way Drive and Bluff Road and is expected to be completed the week of June 27, weather permitting. **A traffic detour remains in place at least through June 27.**

MWRD Repairs on Old Green Bay Road

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District (MWRD) is continuing work to repair the collapse on its sewer manhole on Old Green Bay Road. Crews are constructing a new manhole structure and the project is expected to be complete in early July. **As a reminder, Old Green Bay Road remains closed to through traffic from Park Avenue to Maple Hill Road, and is expected to reopen in early July.** Lincoln Drive, Crescent Drive and Walden Drive will remain open and accessible from Old Green Bay Road to the north and south of the project area. Pedestrian and bicycle traffic can also safely pass the construction area by accessing the sidewalk just east of the roadway between Lincoln Avenue and Walden Avenue. Green Bay Road Median at Tudor Court

Final work on the new pedestrian crossing connecting the Village train station parking lot and the west side of Green Bay Road (just north of Tudor Court) is expected to be complete during the week of June 20. This median provides a safe access point for patrons of Writers Theatre and other downtown businesses who park in the train station lots. We ask that patrons refrain from using the crosswalk until work is complete.
