The Glencoe Community Relations Forum will host its second Community Forum about the water supply planning report on June 27 at the Glencoe Public Library at 10 a.m. The Community Forum will feature an abbreviated version of the presentation made at the May 28 Community Open House on the water supply planning report, as well as question-and-answer sessions. This meeting is will be an informal, informational session in which Village staff and residents can share information, comments, and questions about the Village's water supply plan, and no decisions will be made at these meetings.

FINANCE COMMITTEE – JUNE 16

The Finance Committee met on June 16th and reviewed the monthly financial reports. All Village funds are on target with the Fiscal Year 2016 budget with the general fund being the most positive. Revenues are currently higher than expenses as some capital costs have been delayed.

The Committee also discussed the upcoming bond issuance which is scheduled for the end of July.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – JUNE 18

The Committee of the Whole of the Village Board met on June 18 and received two presentations from Village staff. In the first, the Public Safety Department provided an overview of the Cook County Hazard Mitigation Plan and the Village of Glencoe Emergency Operations Plan, which the Village Board is scheduled to consider for approval at the July Village Board Meeting. Next, Village staff and the Committee discussed possible updates to the Village liquor code in an effort to streamline and simplify the liquor licensing process and to be in line with State of Illinois requirements. This discussion will continue at the July 16th Committee of the Whole meeting.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETING – JUNE 18

At the June 18 Village Board Meeting the Village Board approved several consent agenda items including authorizing the execution of an agreement with Smith Art Conservation for monument restoration of the Frank Lloyd Wright Ravine Bluffs Entrance Feature Monument 3, a contract extension with North Shore Community Bank to provide Village banking services, and an intergovernmental agreement with IDOT for maintenance of municipal streets.

The Board also received a presentation from Family Service of Glencoe's Director of Development Sarah Scherdt on the results of their Community Needs Assessment. Ms. Scherdt reported that they learned that Family Service of Glencoe is viewed as an asset to the community offering many valuable services to meet the needs of Glencoe residents.

The Village Board also approved an ordinance that sets the parameters for the first \$5,000,000 of voter-approved bonds. These funds will be allocated to stormwater and other projects, and letting is expected in July. The second \$5,000,000 in bonds will be issued in early 2016.

The next Village Board meeting will be July 16.
