### DUNDEE ROAD SET TO REOPEN ON MONDAY

As part of the 2016 Storm Water Improvements Project, the new storm sewer installation on Dundee Road between Forest Way Drive and Bluff Road has been completed. Restoration of the asphalt pavement will be completed on Friday and Saturday, and the roadway is expected to be re-opened on Monday, June 27. This work completes the 2016 storm water improvement project.

While restoration work is completed over the weekend, please remember to follow the posted speed limits and watch for construction workers when traveling by the construction area. #### Green Bay Road Median at Tudor Court

The Village's new pedestrian crossing at Green Bay Road just north of Tudor Court is expected to officially open next week. We ask that pedestrians use the crossing at Green Bay Road and Park Avenue and refrain from using the new crosswalk until work is complete.

### MWRD Repairs on Old Green Bay Road

Construction of the new MWRD manhole is expected to be completed the week of June 27. **As a reminder, Old Green Bay Road remains closed to through traffic from Park Avenue to Maple Hill Road, and is expected to reopen in early July.** Lincoln Drive, Crescent Drive and Walden Drive will remain open and accessible from Old Green Bay Road to the north and south of the project area. Pedestrian and bicycle traffic can also safely pass the construction area by accessing the sidewalk just east of the roadway between Lincoln Avenue and Walden Avenue. ### ILLINOIS PGA EVENT AT THE GLENCOE GOLF CLUB


