VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM COMMUNITY FORUM – MONDAY, JUNE 8

The Glencoe Community Relations Forum will host Community Forums about the water supply planning report on June 8 (held at the Glencoe Union Church at 7 p.m.) and June 27 (held at the Glencoe Public Library at 10 a.m.). The Community Forums will feature an abbreviated version of the presentation made at the open house, as well as question-and-answer sessions. These meetings are intended as informational sessions in which Village staff and residents can share information, comments, and questions about the Village's water supply plan, and no decisions will be made at these meetings.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS – JUNE 1

The Zoning Board of Appeals met on June 1 and approved two zoning variation requests as follows:

1. Request of Greg Kavanaugh, 531 Grove, to reduce the required Grove Street front yard setback and the floor area ratio for two roof-top dormers.
2. Request of Elizabeth Falk, 587 Longwood, for a north side yard variation for a north garage dormer expansion and for a floor area ratio variation and accessory building lot coverage variation to retain an arbor structure adjoining the detached garage in conjunction with a planned rear house addition.

The Zoning Commission also met and approved a recommendation for the Village Board of Trustees to approve a special use ordinance request of the Glencoe Historical Society in coordination with the Glencoe Park District and the Village for the reconstruction of the Frank Lloyd Wright-designed Waiting Station at 301 Maple Hill commonly referred to as the east side of the Green Bay Trail just north of Maple Hill Road. The proposed Station requires zoning relief from the front setback requirement from Maple Hill Road and from the north, west, and/or south lot lines.

PLAN COMMISSION – JUNE 3

At the June 3 meeting, members of the Plan Commission voted in favor of a recommendation approving a preliminary and final plat for the Adams Bend Subdivision located at 333 Adams Avenue. The 20,851 square foot property will be divided into two lots: Lot 1 will be 10,422 square feet and Lot 2 will be 10,429 square feet. Both will have an average lot width of 52.06 feet, a reduction from the 60-feet required, approved as a variation by the Zoning Board of Appeals on September 8, 2014. Property owner Pawel Lewandowski will demolish the existing 1-1/2 story frame single family residence and detached garage and will construct two new homes with attached garages. Both lots have been designed to conform to the Village's storm water requirements for new single family development and both homes will have their own storm service that ties directly into the Village's main on Adams Avenue. The property currently has no storm sewer facilities. Pending final approval of the Village Board, construction is expected to begin this summer. The next Plan Commission meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 23.
