GLENCOE TUNE-UP BOOTH AT FARMER'S MARKET

Share your thoughts on Downtown - participate in our Tune Up! Starting Saturday, July 12, and continuing regularly through the summer, members of the Plan Commission and staff will be manning a booth at the Glencoe Farmer's Market Saturday mornings from approximately 9:30am to 11:00am to promote the Downtown Glencoe Tune-up. Representatives will be present to meet residents, discuss the project, and encourage participation through a variety of means such as visiting the project website (www.glencotuneup.com), downloading the mobile app, attending Plan Commission meetings and panel discussions, completing surveys, and sharing ideas on the Community Input Boards – "Downtown Glencoe Would Be Better If..." – located in Wyman Green. The Glencoe Tune-up officially kicked off May 28th with a Plan Commission walking tour of downtown and is expected to extend into spring 2015.

ELM PLACE BASIN IMPROVEMENTS

The Elm Place Basin Storm Sewer Improvement Project has reached the intersection of Forestway and Chestnut and is advancing on schedule. The contractor will temporarily bypass this intersection while North Shore Gas makes adjustments to a gas main that interferes with the path of the new storm sewer. The contractor will continue with storm sewer installation on Chestnut and move east to Oak and then north to Stonegate while North Shore Gas completes their work.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS AND ZONING COMMISSION MEETINGS

Both the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Zoning Commission met on July 7. The zoning variation request of Pawel Lewandowski to reduce the average lot width for each of two proposed buildable lots for the subdivision of the property at 333 Adams was continued to August 4 at the owner's request.

In response to a referral by the Village Board made in late 2012, the Zoning Commission held a public hearing to consider testimony concerning whether the Zoning Code should be amended in light of the State of Illinois adoption of the Compassionate use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act. The Act includes state-authorized medical cannabis dispensing locations and cultivation centers.

When plotted on a Village map using Glencoe's Geographic Information System (GIS), there were no locations in the Village's corporate limits that would meet the location requirements for cultivation centers, however, there were two area locations that could meet dispensing location requirements. One of these is the far eastern area of the central business district from the Harris Bank building east to Green Bay Road; the other in the Hubbard Woods Shopping Center from approximately the new Binny's store location north to the 7-Eleven. Associate Village Attorney Stewart Weiss noted the practical difficulties of Glencoe locations meeting a number of state requirements including 24 hour surveillance cameras on a full perimeter around the building exterior, secure loading dock/delivery locations, etc. After a lengthy review, the Zoning Commission approved a motion to not

recommend any zoning code changes, with adherence to state requirements, believing state regulations to be strict enough given the location limitations in Glencoe. This item will be presented to the Village Board at their August meeting.
