GREEN BAY ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Asphalt paving work on the final surface course began on Friday, July 24 and will continue on Saturday and Monday, weather permitting. The phasing of the asphalt paving work will impact traffic flow, and will result in lane closures and short stoppages of traffic.

While Green Bay Road remains open to traffic, the Village encourages motorists and bicyclists to use alternate routes when possible to avoid delays. The Village apologizes for this inconvenience and thanks those who travel on Green Bay Road for your patience and cooperation.

As a reminder, Park and Vernon Avenues downtown will be closed to traffic beginning Friday evening through late Sunday.

FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT RAVINE BLUFF MARKERS AROUND TOWN

Presented by the Glencoe Historical Society, Wright Around Town is a public art project celebrating the 100 year anniversary of the Frank Lloyd Wright Ravine Bluffs subdivision. It is modeled after other successful community art projects such as Chicago's famous Cows on Parade. Fifteen organizations, businesses and community leaders have sponsored artists to convert each marker into a unique work of art. PLAN COMMISSION – JULY 22

At the July 22 meeting, members of the Plan Commission unanimously approved a design review application for exterior modifications to the storefront at 341 Park Avenue in the downtown business district. The space, formerly occupied by Shirise, will become 10 Friends Blow Dry & Style House offering spa quality services focused on shampoo and conditioning treatments, blowouts, and styling. The Glencoe location will be one of three, including downtown Hinsdale and Deer Park Town Center. Renovations to the exterior façade will include new black aluminum clad wood storefront windows and transoms with cedar panels, trim, and cornice painted black. Solid wood exterior doors painted light blue will replace existing glass doors. New fabric awnings will be installed over both front entries. Hours of operation will likely be until 6:00 p.m. with extended hours to 8:00 p.m. on Fridays. The business is expecting to be open by the end of October.
