
### **SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT CONTRACT UNDERWAY**

The Village's annual sidewalk replacement contract work is nearing completion. Schroeder & Schroeder of Skokie was awarded the 2015 contract through the Municipal Partnering Initiative (MPI) program. The MPI is a joint bid program comprised of numerous North Suburban area communities seeking cost savings in bidding out common maintenance and capital improvement projects. Schroeder has been working at various locations throughout the Village on the removal and replacement of concrete sidewalk areas. All work is expected to be completed during the week of August 17, including restoration of construction areas, weather permitting. Thank you for your cooperation during construction.

### **NEWS FROM THE GLENCOE GOLF CLUB**

### **NORTH SHORE ELECTRICITY AGGREGATION CONSORTIUM RFQ-I**

The Village is a member of the North Shore Electricity Aggregation Consortium (NSEAC), a municipal electricity aggregation consortium that also includes the Cities of Highland Park, Lake Forest and Park Ridge and the Villages of Deerfield, Lake Bluff, Northbrook and Skokie. The NSEAC has been working toward gathering additional information about innovative and creative ways to provide savings and additional electricity-related services to residents served by the consortium by providing access to services that may reduce electricity consumption. In this effort, the NSEAC this week issued a Request for Information and Qualifications (RFI-Q) to obtain information about prospective vendors that may be able to provide measurable net energy or energy cost savings to residents through energy efficiency improvements, demand response, energy storage or distributed generation. The outcome of the RFI-Q process will determine how this new NSEAC program can continue to provide value to the member communities.
