ORDINANCE NO. 2009-16-3249

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4
OF THE GLENCOE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING WINE CAFES**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend Chapter 4 of the Glencoe Village Code to include regulations authorizing the licensing of wine cafes as set forth in this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe, County of Cook, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Incorporation of Recital. The foregoing recital is by this reference incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this section.

SECTION TWO: Amendment. Section 4-10, entitled "Classes; fee schedule," of Article III, entitled "Licenses," of Chapter 4, entitled "Alcoholic Beverages," of the Glencoe Village Code shall be, and it is hereby, amended to add a new subsection (r), which subsection (r) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

(r) Class J licenses, which shall authorize (i) the retail sale of beer and wine only in its original package for consumption off the premises where sold, and (ii) the retail sale of beer and wine for consumption on the premises where sold. Such licenses shall only be permitted for premises not exceeding two hundred (200) square feet in area (exclusive of any area of adjacent public areas that might be separately authorized by permit from the village manager pursuant to the Village Code). The sale of beer and wine for consumption on-premises is to be accompanied by food items (whether complementary or for purchase), which food items can be less than a full meal and need not be prepared or maintained on the licensed premises. The annual license fee for such license shall be Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).

SECTION THREE: Amendment to Subsection 4-13(e). Section 4-13, entitled "Limit on number of licenses," of Article III, entitled "Licenses," of Chapter 4, entitled "Alcoholic Beverages," of the Glencoe Village Code shall be and is hereby amended to add a new subsection (r), which subsection (r) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

(r) Class J

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.
