

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-19-3252

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VEHICLES AND PERSONAL  
PROPERTY OWNED BY  
THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE BY SEALED BID OR AUCTION

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Glencoe, it is no longer necessary, or useful, or in the best interests of the Village of Glencoe, to retain ownership of vehicles and personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe to sell/discard said vehicles and personal property by direct sale, donation, trade-in, auction and/or sealed bids, or disposal, for said vehicles personal property according to procedures set forth by the Village Manager in the notice of auction and sealed bid for said personal property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe find that the vehicles and personal property (listed in Exhibit I) now owned by the Village of Glencoe, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Glencoe, and the best interests of the Village of Glencoe will be best served by their disposal.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to ILCS 5/11-76-4 the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned equipment now owned by the Village of Glencoe by direct sale, donation, trade-in, auction and/or *sealed* bids for this property and to sell this equipment to the highest bidder.

SECTION THREE: Upon payment of the full bid price, or by obtaining a favorable trade-in allowance or upon payment of other good and reasonable consideration by the Village, the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to convey and transfer title of the aforesaid personal property, to the successful bidder or dealer.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of the corporate authorities, approval, publication and posting as provided by law.
