

SPECIAL SERVICES

Spring Clean Up - The Village provides, at no charge, an annual one day collection of large quantities of household refuse (furniture, appliances etc.) in mid-May.



Fall Leaf Collection - The Village provides vacuum collection of leaves from the parkway for seven weeks beginning in mid-October.

Please watch our web-site or check the Glencoe Memo for specific dates.

Fluorescent light bulbs are considered special waste and must be collected separate from regular waste. To arrange for a pick-up of fluorescent bulbs call 847-835-4111 ext. 153.

TO START OR STOP SERVICES

Please call the Glencoe Finance Department at 835-4113 to start garbage and recycling collection services or to put a temporary hold on these services while you are away. The Finance Department can also assist you with billing information.

To determine your collection days, for other service related calls or to arrange special garbage pick-ups, please call 835-4111 and ask for the Public Works Department at ext. 153.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

In the event a holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday your regular garbage and recycling pick-up will resume the following day. The Village observes the following refuse collection holidays.

- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas



CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION



Recycling pick-up is once a week and coincides with your regular garbage collection day. Recycling is picked up only at the curb in 65 gallon recycling carts provided by the Village. **Carts must be placed close to the street with the handle facing your house.** All recycling must be ready for collection no later than 7:00 am the day of collection. All recyclables listed below may be placed together in the 65 gallon cart provided. There is no need to

separate. Items in white/black plastic bags will not be accepted.

Paper

- * Newspaper (and all inserts), Direct mail advertising
- * Office paper
- * Magazines, catalogs and phone books
- * Cardboard (must be flattened—can be cut up)
- * Chipboard (flattened cereal, tissue boxes, paper towels, toilet paper rolls, shoe and food boxes)

Not accepted

- * Tyvex paper
- * Photos
- * Tissue Papers
- * Silicon paper
- * Wax paper
- * Foil-lined paper

Cans and Foil

- * Steel (tin cans and bi-metal cans), Empty aerosol cans
- * Aluminum beverage and pet food cans
- * Clean aluminum foil pans and containers

Not accepted

- * Scrap Metal
- * Cookware



Glass

- * All colors of glass bottles and jars. You do not need to remove labels.

Not accepted

- * Ceramics
- * Mirrors
- * Crystal, light bulbs, Pyrex
- * Window glass
- * Drinking glasses

Plastic

- * The Village Recycling Contractor will collect plastics labeled #1 and #2, which make up 85 to 90 percent of the plastics used today. Grout usually accepts other numbers (3, 4, 5, 6 and 7) and recycles them as market conditions allow.

BACKDOOR GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICE

GARBAGE, LANDSCAPE WASTE AND RECYCLING MUST BE OUT AND READY FOR COLLECTION NO LATER THAN 7:00 AM.

The Village provides residential garbage collection of regular household waste. It is collected once per week either curbside or at a spot adjacent to your driveway. Twice per week and supplemental collections are also available and explained later in this brochure.

Regulations for garbage pick-up

Household garbage must be placed in plastic or paper bags and stored in leak-proof metal or plastic containers, no larger than 44 gallons with handles for lifting and tight fitting covers. Loose garbage will not be collected. Broken glass must be wrapped, labeled and placed in a separate container.

A maximum of 4 garbage containers can be placed in one accessible outdoor location within close proximity to your driveway or at the curb.



Village crews are not permitted to enter homes, garages, porches or other private property structures to collect garbage.

Refuse will not be collected if snow and ice are not reasonably cleared from driveways and walks.

All garbage, landscape waste and recycling must be ready for collection no later than 7:00 am the day of collection. Garbage out after 7:00 am runs a risk of not being collected until the next regular pickup day.

The Village will not collect building materials such as concrete, dirt, stone, brick, floor tile, roofing, shingles, or lumber. You must contact a private scavenger to dispose of these materials.

If your garbage is not out, is loose in the can, or cars are blocking the cans your route person has been instructed to leave an orange notice tag stating the reason for it not being collected.



GARBAGE COLLECTION OPTIONS

OPTION 1

- Once a week pick-up
- Supply your own garbage container
 - No larger than 44 gallon
 - Maximum of 4 containers
- Back door service (adjacent to driveway or at curb)



OPTION 2

- Once a week pick-up
- Purchase 95 gallon container from Village
 - \$60 per container (one time purchase price)
 - Maximum of 2 containers
- Curbside pick-up only



OPTION 3

- Twice a week pick-up
 - Supply your own 44 gallon container
 - Back door service (adjacent to driveway or at curb)
 - Maximum of 2 containers per pick-up day
- OR
- Purchase 95 gallon container from Village
 - Curbside pick-up only
 - \$60 per container (one time purchase price)

SUPPLEMENTAL HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE PICK-UP

A supplemental pick-up can be scheduled due to an event generating additional regular household garbage. The cost for a supplemental pick-up is \$25.00 and can be scheduled Monday through Friday. Residents are permitted to fill the same number of garbage containers as once a week pick-up. To schedule a supplemental pick up call 847-835-4111 ext. 153.

SPECIAL PICK-UP

The Refuse Division can provide special pick up service of miscellaneous household items at a minimum cost of \$40.00 for the first cubic yard and \$12.00 for each additional yard. Special refuse is considered anything other than your regular household waste (furniture, appliances, boxes, etc.) and does not include hazardous waste (paint, gas, chemicals, etc.) or building material (wood, lumber, drywall, etc.). All special refuse materials must be brought to the curb. The Village requires a minimum 24 hour notice, Tuesday through Friday. To schedule a pick-up, call 847-835-4111 ext. 153.



CURBSIDE LANDSCAPE WASTE COLLECTION

Curbside landscape waste season runs from April 1 through December 15 of each year. Landscape waste is defined as leaves, grass cuttings, twigs, small shrubby clippings, dead plants and flowers. Landscape waste is collected from the curb and needs to be contained in biodegradable paper bags (not plastic bags) or placed loose in reusable plastic or metal 44 gallon containers. Each bag, container or bundle must display a current yard waste collection sticker or item will not be collected. Stickers can be purchased at Village Hall or Grand Foods. Yard waste bags that contain dirt, stone, gravel or trash will not be collected.



The Village will also collect stickered, bundled tree branches and sticks of 4-inch maximum diameter and 4-foot maximum length. The bundles should be bound with biodegradable string or twine, cannot exceed 24 inch maximum diameter, and a proper yard waste collection sticker must be attached to each bundle. Bundles tied with wire will not be accepted.

MISCELLANEOUS

The Village will not collect any hazardous waste such as gasoline, paint thinner, pesticides or paint. Regional household hazardous waste collection days are routinely promoted by the Village. If you are unsure about a material please call the Public Works Department. Accumulation of garbage on the exterior of your property is prohibited.
