

**RESOLUTION NO. R-10-2010**

**NORTH SHORE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH  
CELEBRATES 100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY**

**WHEREAS**, the **NORTH SHORE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** was organized in the Village of Glencoe in 1909, and met for five years in what was then the Glencoe Woman's Library Club; and

**WHEREAS**, the first Sunday morning service was held one hundred years ago on May 15, 1910; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1913, the congregation changed its official name from the Glencoe Methodist Church to the North Shore Methodist Church and made plans for a church building at 213 Hazel Avenue to meet the growing needs of the congregation; and

**WHEREAS**, the main sanctuary building was dedicated in 1915, with further additions to the church building in the 1940s, an expansion in the early 1960s and a major renovation project was completed in 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, the current name of the **NORTH SHORE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** was brought about by the merger between the National Evangelical United Brethren Church and the National Methodist Church; and

**WHEREAS**, the church participates in various outreach projects including the Good News Soup Kitchen and Habitat for Humanity, and the church has a strong music tradition including the choir, pageants and concerts.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe, Illinois, on behalf of the citizens of the Village of Glencoe, express their congratulations on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary and their acknowledgment and appreciation to the **NORTH SHORE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH** for its contributions to the enhancement and enrichment of Glencoe's religious, cultural and civic history.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this proceeding, and that an executed copy of this Resolution, inscribed with the signature of the Village President, and bearing the Corporate Seal of the Village of Glencoe, as attested by the Village Clerk, be presented to the **NORTH SHORE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH**.
