

Resolution No. R-14-2009

Village of Glencoe, Cook County, Illinois
Resolution Establishing Prevailing Wages
Certificate of Compliance
Effective 06/01/2009

WHEREAS, these prevailing wages must be ascertained and included in the contracts and their advertised specifications to which any public body, as defined in Section 2 of the Prevailing Wage Act (Ill. Rev. Stat. 1987, Ch. 48 par. 39s-1 et seq., as amended), is a party, for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and/or repair of public buildings or public works within the State of Illinois which requires or involves the employment of laborers, workers, and mechanics, and owner/operators and said Prevailing Wages shall be the minimum wages, overtime rate and fringe benefits paid for such work.

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that said rates of pay be publicly posted and/or kept available for inspection by any interested party, that a certified copy thereof be promptly filed in the office of the Secretary of State and the Illinois Department of Labor and that the rates be published in a newspaper of general circulation,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of Glencoe, Cook County, State of Illinois, that the determination by the Illinois Department of Labor of the prevailing wages in Cook County as set forth in the attached shall be the prevailing hourly rates of wages being paid to all laborers, workmen, and mechanics engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the President and Board of Trustees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages in Cook County by the Illinois Department of Labor shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction under the jurisdiction of the President and Board of Trustees, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply to the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the Village of Glencoe for employment other than public works construction as defined in the Act, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Secretary of State and the Illinois Department of Labor and to publish this certified copy in a newspaper of general circulation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination and to attach a copy of this determination or of the revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect to

all public works construction contract specifications.
